TOEFL – Test of English as a Foreign Language

Applicants sponsored by an U.S. diocese for whom English is a second language (ESL = English as a Second Language) must take the TOEFL examination. This is part of the application process for college students at the Josephinum.

The results of this examination should be sent to the Registrar's Office when application is made to enter the College or School of Theology.

Those who score Six-hundred (**550**) paper-based, **213** computer-based, and **80** on the TOEFL iBT (internet-based test) or above will be eligible for admission into the College of Liberal Arts or School of Theology. ([link](#) to ESL Program).

Applicants with scores less than 550/213 will take only ESL courses until they attain the target score. In most cases, the English language studies will last a minimum of one (1) year.

The TOEFL examination is administered at the Josephinum.
